Position Overview

The Summer Programs Teacher provides highly interactive educational experiences and lessons to The Discovery Museum’s summer programs participants. The Teacher delivers programs onsite in the classrooms and is responsible for the management of students and counselors, and for the preparation of classroom activities for students throughout summer programs by weekly session.

Major Tasks and Responsibilities

- Prepare weekly newsletter reports to parents regarding classroom activities
- Discuss behavioral issues with parents/guardians as necessary

- Ensure that all programs are performed in a manner that is consistent with the Museum’s approach to STEM teaching and learning
